

Notice of Privacy Practice Policy

This notice describes how medical information about you may be used and how you get access to this information. <u>Please review carefully.</u>

Purpose of this notice

Our office respects the privacy of personal information and understands the importance of keeping this information confidential and secure. This notice describes our privacy practices with respect to your health information. Our privacy practices apply to current and former patients.

Types of Personal and Health Information We Collect

We collect a variety of personal and health information when delivering health care. You provide some of this information when you initially come into the office (such as address, social security number, and health history). We also receive additional personal and health information, such as eligibility, through our transaction with employers, insurance companies, and other health care providers. We limit the collection of personal information to that which is necessary to administer our business, provide quality services, and meet regulatory requirements.

How we Protect Personal and Health Information

We treat personal and health information securely and confidentially. We limit access to personal information to only those persons who need to know the information to provide services to patients. These persons are trained on the importance of safeguarding this information and must comply with our procedures and applicable law. We meet physical, electronic, and procedural security standards to protect personal and health information and maintain internal procedures to promote the integrity and accuracy of that information.

Disclosure of Personal and Health Information

We may share any of the personal and health information we collect (as described above) with our associates as permitted by law. We do not disclose personal or health information to any other third parties without a patient's request or authorization.

Individual Rights to Access & Correct Personal and Health Information

We have procedures for a patient to access the personal and health information we collect, and other than information we collect in connection with, or in anticipation of, a lawsuit or legal claim, we will make this information available to the patient upon request.

Our goal is to keep our patient information up-to-date and to correct inaccurate information. We have procedures in place to ensure the integrity of our information and for the timely correction of incorrect information. If you believe than any personal or health information we have about you is not accurate, please let us know by contacting our office.
